**Suitable extinguishing media**

**6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES****Personal precautions**

Keep away from sources of ignition - No smoking. Take measures to prevent the build up of electrostatic charge.

**Storage**

Keep container tightly closed in a dry and well-ventilated place. Containers which are opened must be carefully resealed and kept upright to prevent leakage. Store in cool place.

Store under inert gas. Air sensitive.
